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**RIVER WALK TRAILS**

Farmington offers outdoor lovers over eight miles of trails to explore along the Animas River. **Difficulty of trails:** Grade 2, some grade changes and uneven surfaces. **Surface:** 8 ft. wide crusher fine, concrete pavers, and wood-plank bridges.

**PADDLE TRAILS**

The Animas and San Juan Rivers host a variety of opportunities for recreation. Please note the flow along these rivers varies seasonally. The Animas River is too low for rafting below 600 cfs. Projects are in place that may change the location of diversions and landings. Before you paddle, visit [FarmingtonNM.org](http://FarmingtonNM.org) for updates and additional information.

**ANIMAS RIVER**

- AZTEC — PENNY LANE Distance: 7.3 miles
- PENNY LANE — ANIMAS PARK Distance: 5.5 miles
- ANIMAS PARK — BOYD Distance: 5.5 miles
- BOYD — CONFLUENCE Distance: 1.4 miles
- CONFLUENCE — WESTLAND Distance: 3.2 miles
- WESTLAND — KIRTLAND Distance: 4.9 miles

**SAN JUAN RIVER**

- BLOOMFIELD — MCGEE PARK Distance: 4.9 miles
- MCGEE PARK — CONFLUENCE Distance: 4.9 miles

**OFF ROAD TRAILS**

Farmington is well known for off-roading. This map features a selection of trails in the Glade Run Recreation Area. Be sure to visit the map kiosk at Brown Springs for trail information and visit [FarmingtonNM.org](http://FarmingtonNM.org) for information on additional OHV recreation areas.

Take a look at this mix of trails, depending upon your driving skills and vehicle.

- ARCH TRAIL**  
Trail Rating: 4 — Great for assessing your driving skills and learning what your vehicle is capable of.
- RJ'S TRAIL**  
Trail Rating: 6 — Challenging trail with some rough obstacles; most are bypassable.
- COBRA TRAIL**  
Trail Rating: 5 — Above average driving skills are desirable. Your vehicle approach and departure angles are very important.
- GLADIATOR TRAIL**  
Trail Rating: 6 — Challenging trail with some rough obstacles; most are bypassable.
- WATERFALL TRAIL**  
Trail Rating: 8 — A winch or tow strap is desirable. Possible roll-overs exist.
- UPPER RIM TRAIL**  
Trail Rating: 3 — Above average driving skills are desirable. Your vehicle approach and departure angles are very important.
- LOWER RIM TRAIL**  
Trail Rating: 4 — Great for assessing your driving skills and learning what your vehicle is capable of.

**EQUESTRIAN TRAILS**

A peaceful horseback ride is the perfect way to cap off a day exploring Farmington's cultural and historical assets. Please note these horse-friendly trails are also shared with hikers and runners so be on the lookout while taking in the scenery! - SHERIFF'S POSSE TRAIL**  
Moderate: Experience beautiful wildflowers and exquisite scenery on this loop.
- INNER LOOP** 6.3 miles
- OUTER LOOP** 6.6 miles

**MOUNTAIN BIKING**

- ANASAZI TRAIL**  
Distance: 2.8 miles      Easy to Intermediate  
A fast short loop that can be added on to longer trails like Kinsey to extend your ride time.
- ROAD APPLE RALLY TRAIL**  
Distance: 30.1 miles      Intermediate  
This fast flowing ride features a rolling singletrack plus roads through piñon, juniper, sandstone and badland landscapes.
- KINSEY TRAIL**  
Distance: 3.7 miles      Intermediate  
A sandy yet firm trail with rolling dips and turns.
- FOOTHILLS LOOP**  
Distance: 9 miles      Intermediate  
This loop takes you along a ridgeline for a beautiful view and fast-paced ride.
